### Selective Control of Woody and Invasive Vegetation

We focus on managing trees, brush, and woody stem species that interfere with utility ROWs. By selectively treating this vegetation, we prevent regrowth at the root level and establish stable, low-growing plant communities that require less disruption over time. It is meant to resemble a native prairie habitat.

While these products are regulated as pesticides, every product we use is:

- Labeled for utility ROW application
- Applied by trained professionals
- Used in compliance with federal and state regulations

ROW labeling means the products have been evaluated for use in shared spaces around:
